## Principal's Report

Dear Paradise Valley Families, Our After-School Program is slated to begin sometime this week. The program will run through May 12th. Please carefully read the program guidelines and requirements that were previously sent home with your child. Our program will primarily focus on those students who are experiencing barriers related to their academic achievement. Other offerings could include a 'walk-in' math tutorial club and possibly an accelerated remedial reading program called "Phono-Graphics". This program will provide support in the areas of phonemic development and phonological awareness. Further information about both these supports, which are new this year, will be forthcoming.

In addition, our "Saturday English Language Development Academy" will begin on or around February 19<sup>th</sup>. Our first session will be a student sign-up and program overview. This program will primarily be to support our 2<sup>nd</sup> grade language learners; however, any PV students may participate in this program. The program's focus will be on oral language development, reading, and writing. We will also attempt to include the math club and possibly the "Phono-Graphics" reading program.

Please keep in mind that the state testing (CST) is scheduled to begin on or around the first full week in April. Additional information will be sent home in the sub-


